***Dear Parents/Carers,***

### ***Parents' Evenings***

This year our main parent/teacher consultation evenings will be held on **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March (4:00 – 6:30pm)** and **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March (4:00 – 6:30pm)**.

At parent/teacher consultation meetings parents will have the opportunity to discuss their children's progress and how learning can best be supported at home. Interviews will be in the classrooms and chairs will be placed in the corridor for parents who are waiting. Consultations are intended to be with parents; it would be appreciated if children do not attend. **If it is essential for children to accompany their parents, they should wait quietly outside classrooms. Please remember that it is parents' responsibility to ensure that children are well-behaved.**

Interviews will last for about five minutes and the last appointment each evening will begin 10 minutes before the end time. Parents should complete the form which has been given to their eldest child to take home including date and time preferences and to be returned by next **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March**.

I will be available for parents' evenings; please feel free to drop in but to be sure of seeing me when it's most convenient for you it is advisable to phone the school office or email me direct beforehand to make an appointment.

### ***Sport Relief 2020 – 'Game On'***



Next Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March it is the biennial Sport Relief day (theme is 'Game On'). This will be a non-uniform day and it would be good if the children could dress up as famous sports stars and donate at least 50p per child to the Sport Relief charity for this privilege. If you are interested in coming in for the Mothers' Day meal/s please submit your menu choice/s and pay on *ParentPay* £2.76 per adult meal (£2.30 for a Key Stage 2 child meal) by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March for the meals for Reception, Years 1 and 2 and by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March for the meal for Years 3 – 6.**

**It is really important that all choices and payments are made by the applicable dates. These meals are always really popular and kitchen staff have to order food well in advance.**

It would be appreciated if just Mum (OR another adult) accompanies your child. Please be aware that your child is expected to eat a school meal with you.
