

# Pupil Charter

During this time, we must all work together to make sure that we all stay safe, to help us we need you to:

- Wash your hands before you leave home before school and when you get back home after school.
- Come to school on time and when you get here stay together with your grown-ups, who will help you stay 2m away from other families.
- Sanitise your hands every time you leave or enter your classroom.
- Wash your hands when your teacher asks you to and always when you have been to the toilet.
- Sing 'Happy Birthday' twice when you are washing your hands to kill the virus.
- If you cough or sneeze remember to 'CATCH IT, BIN IT, KILL IT' then wash your hands with soap or use sanitiser.
- Not cough, sneeze or spit near another person.
- Stay in your class group as you move around school and not interact with other children and staff from outside your class group.
- Try your best not to touch other children and staff.
- Use your own equipment from your pencil box and ask a grown up if you need something.
- Only play with your own class's play equipment at lunchtimes and breaktimes.
- When reading at home, you should wash your hands before you get your book out and make sure that you put it away in your wallet as soon as you have finished.
- Tell the teacher straight away if you feel poorly, you have a cough or you feel hot so that they can help you.
- Try your best to follow the new rules, listening to your teachers and asking for help if you need it.
