



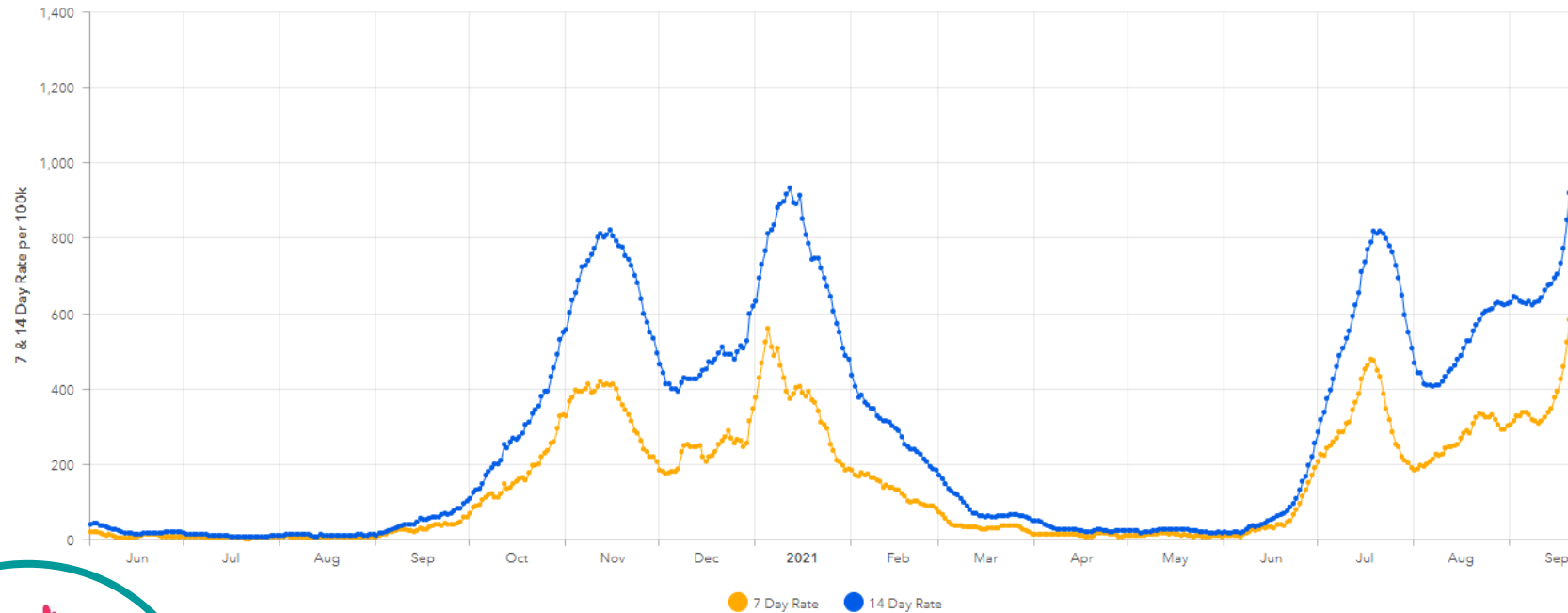

### Keep:

- Recommendations for testing and isolation

- Implementing consistent bubbles for children and staff.
- Restricting visitors to the school site.
- Cancelling all whole-school events inc. worship, social events, clubs etc.
- Restricting extra-curricular activities to maintain integrity of school bubbles.
- Asking parents/carers to maintain 2m social distance on drop off and collection.

## Changes to Isolation and Testing Recommendations

If your child has <b>no symptoms</b> and is <b>generally well</b>	Parents/carers advised to take regular lateral flow tests (recommended twice weekly)
If your child has <b>symptoms of Covid-19</b> (cough, temperature, loss of taste/smell) or they are <b>generally unwell</b>	Stay at home and arrange for a PCR test and isolate until result is received.
If you have a <b>positive case</b> of Covid-19 within your <b>household</b> (sibling/parent)	Stay at home and take a PCR test before child is due to return to school.
If your child is a contact of a <b>positive case</b> in <b>school/ wider community</b> .	Arrange for a PCR test and, where possible, stay at home until the result is returned. If returning to school whilst awaiting results, child must be generally well and have returned daily negative lateral flow tests.
