This year's festival will be held virtually and we invite you to support us in offering a hand of friendship to those less fortunate at this difficult time. Following the success of last year's harvest donations, which helped those both near and far, we are proud to be supporting House of Bread in Stafford, as well as our local elderly residents in partnership with the Hixon Luncheon Club again this year.

House of Bread is a local charity which supports vulnerable and homeless people in Stafford and the surrounding areas. The service provides food and clothing banks, practical support sessions, social activities and a pay what you can café to anyone who needs it.

To support us in this work, Years 5 and 6 are invited to bring in a small harvest basket (this could be a decorated shoe box or similar) containing small food items which will be delivered to residents in need within the local area. Whilst learners in Flourish, Reception and Years 1 to 4, are invited to donate an item to the school's House of Bread collection. Non-perishable food items, for example: tinned foods, pasta, UHT milk, teabags etc. and toiletries would be very warmly welcomed.

Please bring any donations into school on Friday 8th October where they will be blessed as part of our harvest festival celebrations before being distributed to our charity partners. We look forward to sharing our celebrations with you on 8th October and thank you for your support and kindness.
