

English

As **writers** we are learning to write to explain. This means that we are going to be exploring a range of texts and discussing how the writers share facts, instructions and information with the reader. We will analyse the key features of each text in order to understand the skills needed to develop an explanation text. We will be working on then editing and improving our own writing.

In **spelling** we are learning words with suffixes that alter the root of the word.

In **grammar** we are solidifying our understanding of fronted adverbials, as well as applying homophones accurately.


As **readers**, we are reading ...



Through these texts we are focussing on developing our **retrieval and explaining** skills.


Maths

As **mathematicians** we are starting by learning about **Measurement: Length and Perimeter**. We will then go on to develop our understanding of **Multiplication and Division**.



We do this by ...

Using counters, dienes, bar models, and more.



In our **core skills** sessions we will be...

- Applying our understanding of the 9 times table
- Finding fractions of a number
- Multiplying 3 single-digit numbers together
- Adding and Subtractions 2 4-digit numbers

Science

As **scientists** we are learning about evolution and inheritance. We will learn that plants and animals, including humans, resemble their parents in many features.

We will learn to recognise that living things change over time and that fossils provide information about life on Earth millions of years ago.

We will learn to identify similarities and differences between living things and their offspring, alongside labelling diagrams and understanding adaptation.

We will develop our **scientific investigation skills** through asking questions, observing closely and identifying and classifying into different groups.

History

As **Historians** we are learning about ... **Ancient Egypt**. Through our exploration of key historical enquiries, we will learn about...

The achievements of the Ancient Egyptians, by studying what was left behind (artefacts) and exploring investigations.

We will develop our **historical skills** through understanding chronology, build on local, national and world history and also communicate historically

Physical Education

As **sports people** we are learning ...

- Striking and Fielding
- Fitness

These activities will help to...

- build our skills of playing in a team
- develop technique
- give us the understanding to live a healthier lifestyle.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic

In **PSHE** we are learning about ... '**Happy and Healthy Me**'

We will be discussing what keeps us healthy and what can make us unwell. We will also be having discussions about good and bad habits and the importance of keep ourselves happy and healthy.

Design Technology

In Design Technology, we are learning to create our own cushion.

We will begin our learning by analysing existing products and discussing their purpose, design, material and size.

We will then go on to design our own cushion, thinking about meeting our intended ideas.

We will finish this half term by sewing our own cushion and then adding our own design.

Music

As **musicians** we are learning ...



We are continuing to learn to play the ukulele with Mr Omer. We are beginning to learn songs as well as recognising the notes and how to play them. We are also building our understanding of keeping a beat and playing in unison.

Religious Education

As **theologians** we are learning about ... **Incarnation and the Trinity**.

We are learning about the words used to describe the persons of the trinity in the Bible.

We are also learning about infant and adult baptism and the similarities and differences between these.

We will explore the Christian beliefs about the trinity and describe how Christians show their beliefs in how they live.

Throughout our RE lessons, we will be reading texts and teaching from the Bible, to make links between ideas and beliefs and how Christians behave based on the teachings.

Collective Worship

In our **worship** this half-term we are focussing on the value of **perseverance**.

We will be taking time each day to reflect on how and when we have persevered through our lives.

We will be reading texts from the Bible to help us to understand perseverance in more detail.
