Families will be positioned on the bank next to the running track so that they can see all of the action. Families are invited to bring a chair or picnic blanket with them for comfort and we expect the event to last around 1 ½ hours, with children ready for normal end of day collection times.

As always with sports events, we will be keeping a close eye on the weather to ensure that the event can go ahead safely and in the event that we need to postpone we will endeavour to let you know as early as possible.
