Dear Parents/Carers of learners in Key Stage 2,

RE: New Vic – Theatre Trip
Thursday 8th December 2022

As Covid restrictions have been fully removed, we are delighted to be able to offer our children the chance to visit the theatre once again as part of their Key Stage 2 learning adventure. This year we will be visiting the New Vic theatre in Stoke to watch their amazing Christmas performance of 'Alice in Wonderland'.

As well as offering our children a magical storytelling experience, which will enhance and develop our children's writing over the subsequent weeks; the New Vic also offers our learners the opportunity to experience theatre in the round, which is a fully immersive theatre experience, where children really feel part of the action. The children are familiar with such theatres through their studies of Ancient Rome and Ancient Greece in History, however many of our children have not had the opportunity to experience this for themselves.

On the day of the visit, children will have lunch in school before embarking the coach to the theatre at 12.45pm. The performance begins at 2.15pm and is anticipated to finish at 4.15pm, after this we will travel back to school by coach to arrive in Hixon for approximately 5.15pm (actual collection times will be communicated via dojo on the day).

As a school group, tickets for this performance are discounted to £16.00 per person, which includes a vanilla ice-cream (or dairy free alternative) during the interval, and our wonderful PTFA have agreed to contribute the full cost of the coach travel (£875, equating to £8.33 per child) to reduce the cost of the visit at this very expensive time of year. We are therefore requesting **parent contributions of £16.00 per child**. This payment has been added to your ParentPay account and should be paid in full by **1st December 2022**. If you would prefer to pay this in instalments, please let Mrs Haenelt know so that she can set this up for you.

For children currently in receipt of free school meals, educational visits are subsidised by your child's Pupil Premium funding. Mrs Haenelt will be in touch with you directly following completion of the form below, however if you are not in receipt of free school meals, but need support in meeting the cost of this visit, please do speak with us so that we can work with you to find a positive solution for you and your child.

We kindly ask that you complete the reply slip below to give your consent for your child to attend this educational visit by Tuesday 1st November 2022 to enable us to finalise numbers with the theatre and ensure that payment is received in full by 1st December 2022.

With thanks for your support and contributions and we look forward to sharing this wonderful experience with all our learners in Key Stage 2 on 8th December,
