Dear Parents/Carers of learners in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2,

## RE: Amerton Farm and Santa Train Visit

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022

As Covid restrictions have been fully removed, we are delighted to be able to offer our children the chance to visit the Santa once again as part of their Early Years and Key Stage 1 learning adventures. This year we will be visiting Amerton Farm to visit Santa and ride on the Santa Express.

During the visit children will have the opportunity to visit Santa's grotto, escorted by Santa's elves for fun and games, as well as post letters to Santa in the North Pole postbox and visit Santa's reindeers out on the farm. Whilst out and about on the farm, learners will experience a tractor ride and meet lots of farmyard animals, finding out about where they live and what they eat. The day will culminate in a ride on the Santa express which will enable all our learners to see the farm and the animals from a different angle.

On the day of the visit, children will come into school as normal before embarking the coach to Amerton farm at approx. 9.30am. They will move around the activities at the farm in small groups, supported by school staff and will be transported back to school by coach ready for normal collection time. All children will require a packed lunch (these will be provided by the school through universal infant free school meals, however you are able to pack your child a lunch from home if you prefer) and a water bottle. Uniform does not need to be worn on this day, with warm clothes, wellies, coats and hats/scarves a must as we will be outside for the full day.

The total cost of this experience is £12.00 (made up of £11 for Santa visit and £1 for the train ride) and our wonderful PTFA have agreed to contribute the full cost of the coach travel to and from Amerton Farm (£625, equating to £7.27 per child) to reduce the cost of the visit at this very expensive time of year. We are therefore requesting **parent contributions of £12.00 per child**. This payment has been added to your ParentPay account and should be paid in full by **November 25<sup>th</sup>**. If you would prefer to pay this in instalments, please let Mrs Haenelt know so that she can set this up for you.

For children currently in receipt of free school meals, educational visits are subsidised by your child's Pupil Premium funding. Mrs Haenelt will be in touch with you directly following completion of the form below, however if you are not in receipt of free school meals, but need support in meeting the cost of this visit, please do speak with us so that we can work with you to find a positive solution for you and your child.

We kindly ask that you complete the reply slip below to give your consent for your child to attend this educational visit by Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 to enable us to finalise numbers with the theatre and ensure that payment is received in full by 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

With thanks for your support and contributions and we look forward to sharing this wonderful experience with all our learners in Reception and Key Stage 1 on 30<sup>th</sup> November,
