Unfortunately, as only 30 people crossed the road during the drop-off period, we are sadly not eligible for a crossing patrol. However, there was a marked difference in parking whilst the assessment was completed and the crossing was much safer without cars parked in this area – so whilst we continue to campaign for this; could I thank parents for choosing not to park close to the pedestrian crossing and ensuring that our children can cross safely on their way to and from school.
