Reading Opens Every Door

Reading remains our highest priority.

- ✓ Read for at least 15 minutes every day
- ✓ Record your reading independently in your Reading Diary
- ✓ Read aloud to an adult at least once a week

Parents can help by:

- Listening to reading regularly
- Discussing books together
- Encouraging reading for pleasure
- Adding a brief weekly comment in the Reading Diary

Regular reading is the single biggest thing you can do to support your child's success.



Homework

Homework encourages independence and prepares children for secondary school.

Children should complete:

- ✓ Daily reading
- ✓ TT Rock Stars (approx. 5 minutes daily where appropriate)
- ✓ 30 minutes of Century learning each week
- ✓ Accelerated Reader quizzes

Homework is monitored regularly and consistent effort is recognised and celebrated.



Ready to Learn

Please help your child arrive at school ready to learn by ensuring they have:

- ✓ Correct school uniform
- ✓ Named clothing
- ✓ PE kit (Thursday)
- ✓ Reading book and Reading Diary
- ✓ Standard-sized water bottle

Please remember:

- All stationery is provided
- Personal colouring pencils/felt tips may be stored in lockers if preferred
- No toys or personal items in school
- Mobile phones (where needed) will be stored securely in school during the day



Attendance Matters

Excellent attendance is particularly important in Year 6.

Please help your child by:

- ✓ Attending school every day wherever possible.
- ✓ Arriving promptly for an 8.40am start.
- ✓ Avoiding holidays during term time.
